FEATURED CLIENT - CUMMIN'S RECOVERY AFTER MAJOR FLOOD

In June 2008, the East Fork White River crested almost 10 feet above its banks, flooding the city of Columbus, Indiana, and impacting operations at Cummins, a global manufacturer of diesel engines, power systems and generators.

ERMCO was part of the recovery team working with Cummins and the local electricity supplier, Duke Energy. The first step was to clean flooded equipment and assess damage at three Cummins facilities – the Tech Center, Engine Plant and a small healthcare facility.

ERMCO staff worked seven days a week for six weeks, often up to 16 hours each day. The ERMCO team started with 10 electricians on site but quickly ramped up to a daily average of 50 to 60 electricians.

Switchgear and substations were cleaned so they could be re-energized. Temporary generators were set up so manufacturing areas could quickly restart operations. In the Tech Center, ERMCO replaced all underground wiring and all 600V and 120V circuits. We helped survey building circuiting and document current status. The team identified all circuiting including medium-voltage, electrical panels, transformers, test cells and individual receptacles.

ERMCO tracked all activities associated with the clean-up efforts and provided the needed documentation for insurance requirements.
