The 224-bed tower includes a 90,000-square-foot emergency department as well as a pharmacy, wet labs, central sterile department, NICU, bone marrow transplant center, ORs, PICUs, and CICUs. The project was completed with over 30% MWBE project participation and workforce inclusion.

The Center provides a new model of coordinated care that treats mother and baby as one patient and surrounds them with the medical support they need. Able to accommodate 3,800+ deliveries each year, it houses the largest number of neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) beds in Indiana.
